In order to finish a book in the year, it is necessary to do two questions a night on most nights. K4T is set up in a way that a clubber can complete two books (all twelve doctrinal themes) in each grade level. We understand that not every child is geared to be able to say two verses every night. However, we strongly encourage that a child come ready to say at least one. Children can go back and say verses that were missed, but ask that they do not work ahead.

Cost
